NOTES: Election Night totals were obviously incomplete. By Friday, November 6th the totals had risen by 964 votes, of which Owens got 470 (49%), Hoffman got 481 (50%), and Scozzafava got 13 (1%). Whether or not these changes included any corrective adjustments is not clear. The most anomalous precincts were Bombay, where Hoffman got only 35% of the vote, and Brandon, where Owens got only 38% of the vote. I personally witnessed a profusion of Hoffman yard signs in the Fort Covington and Bombay area.
