NOTES:

In Jefferson County, Sean M. Hennessey, Democratic elections commissioner, said that poll inspectors in four districts reported that Hoffman had received zero votes after inadvertently reading the wrong line of the poll system's printout. Hennessey said that results in some other districts were either incorrectly relayed by the poll worker or incorrectly typed by the part-time staff answering phones at the Jefferson County Board of Elections office.

Jefferson County election officials blamed the mistakes on "chaos" in their call-in center, and on inspectors who read numbers incorrectly when reporting results over the phone.

"The machines were not at fault," said Jerry O. Eaton, Republican elections commissioner for Jefferson County. "It's all human error that happens every election."

Jefferson County has not conducted a manual paper ballot recount.

The totals in the spreadsheet supersede the totals reported in the Watertown Daily Times. 1185 votes were added to the totals, of which Owens got 242 (20%), Hoffman got 919 (78%), and Scozzafava got 24 (2%). Clearly these numbers incorporate the corrections and adjustments made in the four districts where Hoffman was initially assigned zero votes.

The results were clearly wrong in two other election districts as well. In Wilna's 5th district, Hoffman got only 7 votes (2%); his votes went to Scozzafava, and votes from her Independence party line went to Hoffman. In one district in Watertown, Hoffman got only 3 votes (3%); his votes went to Owens, and votes from his Working Families party line went to Hoffman.

According to a later report: In Jefferson County, where Owens was reported to lead by 557 votes with 93% of the precincts reporting on Election Night, inspectors found that Hoffman actually won by 424 votes – a net gain of 981 votes for Hoffman. "Mistakes are found, somebody put the wrong number in a column, or numbers are transposed. ... It's not uncommon," said John Conklin, communications director for the New York State Board of Elections.

As Hoffman's lead in Jefferson County was only 120 votes in the spreadsheet shown above, he must have enjoyed a net gain of 437 due to further recanvassing, mostly in these two districts in Wilna and Watertown.
