METHODS: 2008 turnout prediction is first based on an expected increase in registrations from Nov. 2007 to Nov. 2008. I averaged the percent registration increase from Nov. 1999 to Nov. 2000 and the percent registration increase from Nov. 2003 to Nov. 2004. I applied this average to known November 2007 registration numbers to arrive at an estimated registration for Nov. 2008. I then averaged the 2000 and 2004 turnout, and multiplied that average by the 11/08 Projected Registration, to arrive at an estimate for the 2008 turnout. All of these calculations were performed on each county individually. ~Rady Ananda, December 12, 2007.
